

“Brighter Smiles for the New Generation” Home-School Oral Care Activity

Background

The Oral Health Promotion Division (OHPD) of the Department of Health cordially invites your school to join the “Brighter Smiles for the New Generation 2024-25” home-school oral care activity. We look forward to working with you for the betterment of the children’s oral health.

“Brighter Smiles for the New Generation” has been carried out over two decades. Through this programme, kindergarten and nursery children have developed good oral care habits that bring life-long benefits to their oral health. Besides being supported by principals, teachers and parents, the activity is also recognized by dental professionals internationally. It was awarded “The Bright Smiles, Bright Futures Award – Grand Prize” in the 24th International Congress of International Association of Paediatric Dentistry as the best community oral health education programme.

I. Objectives

1. Children brush their teeth with children’s fluoride toothpaste in the morning and before bed at night every day
2. Parents perform supplementary toothbrushing on their children every night
3. Parents remind their children to avoid eating frequently and help them establish a Smart Dietary Habit in order to prevent tooth decay

II. Activity details

The activity will be carried out in 2 stages:

- Stage 1: Enrollment, Activity Materials Collection and Activity Implementation
 - The latest Oral Care Animation “Rescue HeHa Planet” will be uploaded to “OHPD” Youtube Channel in mid-October. Teachers and students can rewatch the oral care animation anytime
 - The online teacher manual will be uploaded to the “Toothclub” website in mid-October
- Stage 2: Result Submission and Collection of Oral Care Tips and Gifts

Activity Implementation

Activity Period: 21 October 2024 to 29 June 2025

- Accompany with your students to watch online oral care animations (“OHPD” YouTube Channel): read stories, play Q & A games, listen to theme song, and read online picture books together
- Record on the Scoreboard according to the Student Oral Care Handbook weekly
- Carry out the “World Oral Health Day” Card Giving Activity

Parent-child Activities:

- Watch the Oral Care Animation and read the Online Picture Books to learn oral care knowledge
